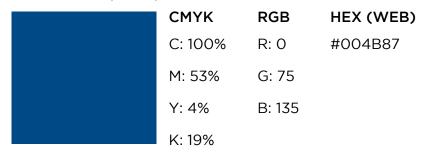

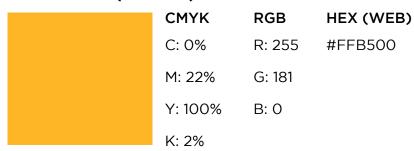
PANTONE COLORS CHART

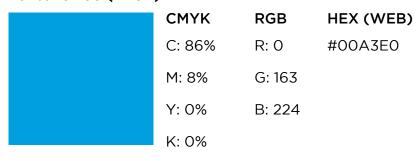

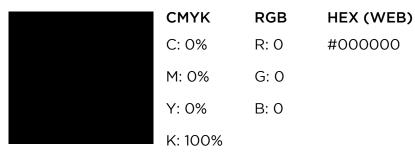
