### Call to Order and Chair's Remarks

Chair Jesse Biter convened the meeting at 9:04 a.m., on February 17, with a quorum. The following members were present: Jesse Biter, Mike Dyer, Claude Delorme, Nyea Sturman, Sean Flynn, Frank Gernert, Bill Wickett, Kevin Smith, and Keith Tribble.

Rick Nafe, Leticia Adams, Frank Gernert, Sean McCaffrey, Caleb Quaid, Kay Rawlins, Kim McDougal, Lauren Strackbine, Jarred Diamond, Marcus Bach-Armas, Lynn Thompson and participated by phone.

Chair Biter recognized special guests: Jamal Sowell, President & CEO Enterprise Florida; Robert Schlotman, COO Enterprise Florida (by phone), Virginia Haley, Executive Director of Visit Sarasota County & Board Chair of Visit Florida, Jason Siegel, President & CEO of the Greater Orlando Sports Commission and Shelby Connett, Director of Sports, Visit Sarasota County.

### Public Comments

Chair Biter opened the meeting for public comments. There were no public comments.

### Host Welcome & Legislative Update

Chair Biter recognized Ms. Haley to provide a legislative update.

Ms. Haley began with thanking the Board for having the meeting in Sarasota. She noted that her current priority was reauthorization for Visit Florida. Visit Florida currently has support from Governor DeSantis and Senate President Galvano. Also, legislation for local destination development tax for communities is under review. Haley shared that 80% of Florida's advertising is through Visit Florida. Visit Florida is the primary voice for communicating that Florida is open for business and promotes positive news during inclement situations and disasters.

### Enterprise Florida President Update

Chair Biter recognized Secretary Sowell to share updates from Enterprise Florida.

Secretary Sowell recognized his guest, Ernest Dubose, CEO of DuCon, LLC. The Secretary highlighted the importance of local communities and bringing businesses to areas that need growth. He noted the importance of marketing the state during hurricane season to show the rest of the country that Florida is still open for business. He also mentioned the Governor is excited about the economic impact that Spring Training brings to Florida and the jobs it creates.

### **Major Grant Presentation**

Jason Siegel presented his major grant to the Board on behalf of the Greater Orlando Sports Commission's Board. The major grant is for Monster Jam. There are 350 performances in 150 markets with media coverage in over 100+ countries. After 19 years in Las Vegas, the organization was looking to send out an RFP to potential host partners for the 2019 & 2020 Monster Jam World Finals. He presented a heat map of where travelers were coming from involving 150 international cities across five continents. The 2019 World Finals brought in an award for economic impact in sports and over 100,000 fans to Orlando. He concluded that the request is for \$100,000 in support of rental space, technology services, and security during the event.

### **Industry Partner Presentation**

Shelby Connett started her presentation by thanking the Foundation's staff for the work done during the Governor's Baseball Dinner. She then went on to state Visit Sarasota County has a team of 18 FTE, including two sports staff members. Last year the organization hosted 99 events with an economic impact of \$149 million and 890,000 participants. Ms. Connett highlighted sporting venues in Sarasota, which included: Nathan Benderson Park, Spring Training stadiums, equestrian centers, and an aquatic center. Some events hosted in Sarasota include: Rowing under 23 Championship, MLB Spring Training, Olympic Rowing Qualifiers, Pan American Masters Championship, and American Quarter Horse Championship. The World Rowing Championships alone brought in an impact of \$5 million. She concluded that Sarasota will host the World Baseball Cup (2021) and Dragon Boat Championship (2022) in the future.

### **Amateur Sports Update**

Board member, Leticia Adams reported that the 2019 Florida Senior Games, presented by Humana, have officially ended.

The 28<sup>th</sup> Florida Senior Games, presented by Humana, started with an opening ceremony on December 6 and was hosted by Mayor Hazel Rogers and the City of Lauderdale Lakes. There were 20 events in 17 locations, with over 1,500 athletes participating in Olympic style sports for Florida residents aged 50 and over. This year's Games saw 12 participants who were over 90 years old. 42 out of 67 Florida counties were represented as well as 36 states and four countries.

The Foundation's Games staff is preparing for the 2020 Sunshine State Games to provide phenomenal experiences and growing the Games. This year's 2020 Sunshine State Games will

include: BMX Bike Racing, ice hockey, footgolf (a combination of soccer and golf), and triathlon. The first event of the 2020 SSG will kick off in Gainesville, March 8, with the Karate/Katsu Challenge. From April – November, the Sunshine State Games will provide Floridians with the opportunity to participate in 30 total games such as water polo, table tennis, lacrosse, pickleball, etc.

In conclusion, the Games staff thanked Chairman Biter, President Angela Suggs, and the Board for their continued support.

### **Approval of Minutes**

Minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting held on November 14, 2019:

Chair Biter asked for a motion to approve the November 14, 2019 meeting minutes. Sean Flynn moved approval of the minutes, as presented. Mr. DeLorme seconded the motion, and the members concurred unanimously.

### **FSF Finance Report**

Chairman Biter provided updates since the last board meeting's report. Charlotte Cowen's retirement became effective January 2, 2020, after 19 years of service to the Foundation. Michelle Roque has resigned from her position at the Foundation. As a result, Enterprise Florida's Brandon Boles, Vice President of Finance & Accounting and Robert Schlotman, COO, will manage the Foundation's finances and administration. The Foundation will hire an accounting director, who will be an Enterprise Florida employee and report to Brandon and a vice president of operations, who will report to the President and assist with finance and managing the day-to-day operations.

Mr. Biter noted that the process for Sports Commissions requesting grant money would not change, and the checks/contracts will continue to come from the Foundation.

### **Financial Update**

Brandon Boles, Vice President of Finance & Accounting, Enterprise Florida, provided the Foundation's financial report. Mr. Boles stated that the revenues appear in line with the budget according to the budget to actual report summary through December 31. Private cash contributions seem to be behind budget, but these may be the timing of the inputs. Total expenses look to be in line with the budget. \$2.7 million is allocated for grant payments, yet some grants will be paid in the future. A cash flow presentation would better help the Board understand cash payments. A cash flow presentation will be provided at a future meeting. Overhead expenses are also near/at budget projections.

Board member, Bill Wickett, thanked Brandon for his help and looks forward to cash flow presentation in the future.

### **Specialty Plate Report**

Mr. Boles reported on tag sales through December 31. The USOC, Tennis, and NASCAR tags net revenue increased more than \$7,000. The sports team's net revenue increase was \$220,000 for the year.

President Angela thanked Mr. Boles, Mr. Schlotman, Chair Biter, and Mr. Wickett for their insight in managing the Foundation's finances. She also noted that the legislative budget request to increase sending authority by 1 million dollars, has been tabled for the 19-20 session. Additionally, she pointed out that a request to spend funds above the \$3 million cap without asking for more spending authority is an additional option for accessing funds.

Chairman Biter, assured the Board that the lack of new spending authority will not impact getting new business as the Foundation will still operate with the current \$3 million budget.

Chairman Biter moved to have Brandon Boles and Robert Schlotman as signers on the Foundation's bank account. 1<sup>st</sup> motion by Mr. Wickett, Mr. McCaffrey seconded the motion, and the members concurred unanimously.

### **Grant Committee Report**

Grant Committee Chair, Bill Wickett, provided a brief recap on 3rd quarter grant activities. \$320,00 was awarded to 24 events. The events produced a \$145 million economic impact, with nearly 135,000 out-of-state visitors.

Ms. Suggs mentioned Broward County is currently going through a restructuring, which has resulted in the withdrawal of grant requests for the quarter. Upon completion of the restructure, we anticipate new grant requests from the county.

Chairman Biter asked for a motion to approve the twenty-four grants recommended by the grant committee. Mr. Dyer moved approval of the grants as presented. Mr. Flynn seconded the motion, and the members concurred unanimously.

### **President's Update**

President Suggs provided updates on activities that will direct the Foundation's movement over the next quarter. In a results-orientated approach, the goal will be to increase opportunities, participation, awareness, programs, private partnerships, and revenues.

Having met with the United States Olympic Committee, the Foundation was made aware of an endowment to be used for Florida athletes in preparation for the Olympics. The Special Olympics will be held in Orlando in 2022.

President Suggs stated that the Foundation will increase its' resources with the addition of a new COO. The Foundation will also push to have effective communication and diversify the audience it reaches. Additionally, the Foundation will pursue a title sponsor for the Sunshine State Games. Finally, opportunities to enhance current partnerships with professional sports teams charitable foundations and increase tag sales will be paramount moving forward.

In comparison to other states, the Foundation has been around since the 90s and is looking for new ways to remain 1<sup>st</sup> in the industry by updating its best practices. The Foundation is looking to bringing back the festival style to showcase Olympic level games in the state. Vice President of Amateur Sports, Mr. Marvin Green, Jr., will seek new opportunities beyond the Foundation. His final day with the organization is March 31.

President Suggs mentioned the Foundation's sponsored events, including: 2020 NFL Pro Bowl, NFL Super Bowl LIV, Power Women in Sports Brunch (Enterprise Award), and Miami Super Bowl Host Committee Hand-Off Ceremony.

The Foundation has three new industry partners to bring the total to 34. St. Augustine Ponte Vedra CVB, Visit Sebring, and Visit South Walton are the latest addition to the Foundation's industry partners. The Foundation also has new sponsors and partners in: AMI Graphics, Caribe International DMC, and Team IP.

The Foundation was able to showcase Florida during the first-ever regional SportAccord. A Florida pavilion that allowed for meetings with rights-holders and a showcase for Florida was featured during the event. President Suggs will attend and present at the upcoming Sportel Conference in Miami. The International SportAccord event in Beijing is postponed. Future meeting/conference attendance and presentations include: International Sports Convention, to be hosted June in London, and the Florida Sports Summit will be held in Flagler Beach.

President Suggs provided an update on the President's Fitness Challenge. She met with Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) leadership to discuss strategies and create a partnership to increase opportunities in youth fitness. There was also a partnership meeting with Sports ETA to continue to receive CSEE training at Foundation events such as the Florida Sports Summit. President Suggs met with Connect Sports on future partnership engagements.

President Suggs concluded with an overview of the 2020 Governor's Baseball Dinner. She thanked Foundation staff along with Ms. Haley, Ms. Connett and George Linley, Executive Director Palm Beach Sports Commission for their support during the Dinner. Board members Mr. Smith and Mr. Tribble also gave special thanks to the staff for a great Governor's Baseball Dinner.

### **Closing Remarks & Adjournment**

Chairman Biter gave special thanks to the staff for putting on an excellent dinner for the Governor. He thanked board member Kevin Smith for his service, as his tenure concludes at the end of the 19-20 fiscal year. With the next Board meeting being a teleconference, the Chair wanted to thank Mr. Smith in person. Mr. Smith expressed thanks for being on the Board and gratitude for all the experiences he has learned being on this side of the process. He also expressed support for President Suggs and the Foundation staff.

Chairman Biter thanked everyone for attending the meeting.

Chair Biter asked for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Flynn made the motion, Mr. DeLorme seconded, and the members concurred unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 10:38 a.m.

**Major Grant Program:**

The Florida Sports Foundation's Major and Regional Grant Programs are designed to assist communities and host organizations in attracting sports events, which will generate significant out-of-state economic impact for the state of Florida. The Foundation's Board of Directors awards grants on a quarterly basis, and places emphasis on economic impact, return on investment, community support and image value to the state.

This quarter, Florida Sports received eighteen, (18), grant applications by the January 10th, 2020 deadline. During a Grant Committee meeting held on January 28th, 18 grant proposals were approved to be presented to the Board of Directors on February 17th, 2020. The Board approved all as presented: 18 grants awarded totaled \$301,498.

**Minor Grant Program:**

**Small Market Grant Program:**

The Florida Sports Foundation's Small Market Grant (SMG) Program operates through its Sports Industry Partnership program, which encompasses all regions of the state of Florida. This program was created to assist events that normally will not exceed \$500,000 in out-of-state economic impact, by offering a grant award not to exceed \$5,000.
