



Larry D. Pendleton President & CEO Florida Sports Foundation 1992-2012

Larry D. Pendleton served as the President and CEO of the Florida Sports Foundation, a not-for-profit organization created in 1992 as the State of Florida's first public-private partnership, through his retirement in 2012. As President and CEO, Pendleton served as Legislative liaison for the state's sports industry and oversaw all facets of the Foundation's daily operations. He was responsible for three official sports tourism publications, industry related conferences, and the major and regional grant program administration for sports events such as the Super Bowl and NCAA Final Four. He also served as the liaison to Florida's sports commissions, which grew significantly during his tenure.

Pendleton oversaw the direction of the "Sunshine State Games", Florida's yearly Olympic style sports festival featuring competition in over 25 sports and the Florida Senior Games, Florida's yearly Olympic style sports festival for participants over 50 years old, featuring 25 sports.

Pendleton developed the Professional Franchise License Tag Program which allowed the Foundation to create the Major and Regional sports events grant program that assists local sports organizations in solicitation of sports events. Pendleton is also credited with creating "PLAY FLA GOLF," a major marketing and promotion program to enhance Florida's golf industry, "BOAT FLORIDA-FISH FLORIDA", a new program created in 2007 to promote Florida's fishing and boating industry. In addition, he was Chairman of the \$60 million Professional Facilities Committee for the Governor.

Prior to joining the Foundation in 1992, Pendleton was Assistant Athletic Director at Florida State University for ten years. He also served Florida State as an academic advisor and football coach from 1973 to 1980. Pendleton is a graduate of Florida State University and was enshrined in the Florida State University Athletics Hall of Fame in September, 2007. He is married and has one daughter, Karissa.

John David is the President & CEO of the Sports Events & Tourism Association (Sports ETA), the leading trade organization for the sports events and tourism industry. With over two decades of experience, he previously served as Chief Strategy Officer at USA BMX, where he helped double membership, triple revenue, and lead major initiatives, including the Olympic Trials and the development of the USA BMX headquarters and Hall of Fame.

Rick was recently elected President of the Florida Sports Hall of Fame, which honors the state's greatest sports figures and promotes fitness, education, and youth engagement through sport.


